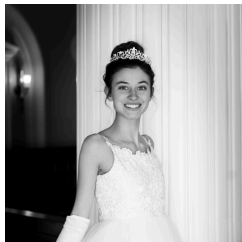

as Lord Pinkleton

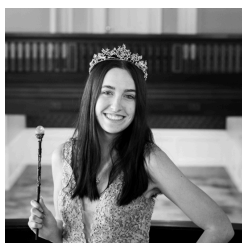

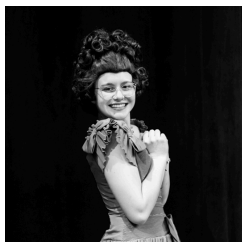

as Madame

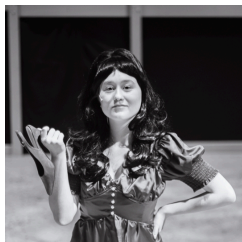

I have seen firsthand how a student's self confidence can grow because of their participation in theatre.
