director's note

Hello, Dolly! is, as a friend of mine put it, "a beast of a show for your first production". He certainly wasn't wrong! I was late coming on to direct, and had only a few weeks of preparation before auditions. With so little time to prepare for a show that is so beloved and timeless in the eyes of so many, I have spent much of the last few months feeling as if I was just spinning in circles with no idea which way was up. Luckily I have been blessed with a really fantastic group of kids, or else this would have been a much more difficult process. Casting 30 teenagers is always a risk, but it paid off in the best way this year. I am so, so proud of them.

I decided early on that I wanted to focus on the silliness and absurdity of the show, and have worked hard with the cast to discover the moments of hilarity within the sincerity. I have had so much fun watching them discover and develop their characters, especially the kids who play multiple roles! Every single one of them have crafted parts fully unique to themselves, and it makes for a very fun and enjoyable performance.

Finally, I would like to acknowledge that I would not be here without one incredible woman. Doré Furstenburg was my high school theatre director, and gave me a six word solo in my very first musical. She directed my glee club and I was her assistant director as she started the elementary school musical program. It was because of her faith in me that I was able to grow my love for performing and end up where I am today. Doré lost her battle with cancer this past November. Our first night of auditions for *Hello, Dolly!* was the same night as her memorial service in my hometown. So many times throughout this process I wished I could text her and ask for her advice. Words are not adequate to describe how much I wish I could have her in the audience here, but I know that God called her home for a reason. As I told the kids at the beginning of this process, every student of her's is a part of her legacy, and as students of mine, they are an extension of that. I am certain that she would be proud of them too.
